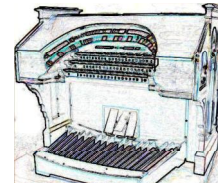

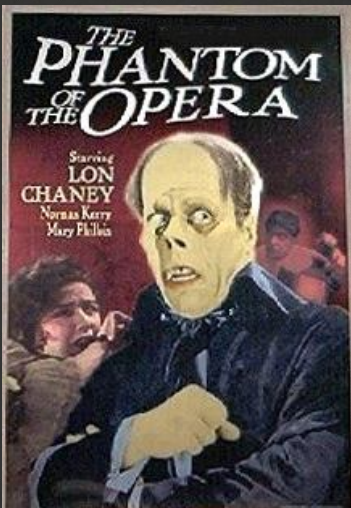

Tucker Hill Residential Community is

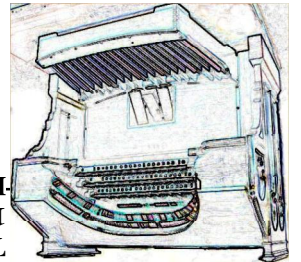
