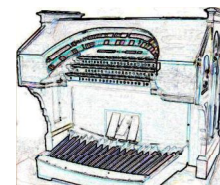

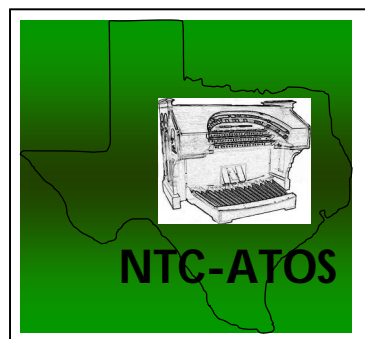
Well, it's that time of year again – the NTC-ATOS Annual Meeting.

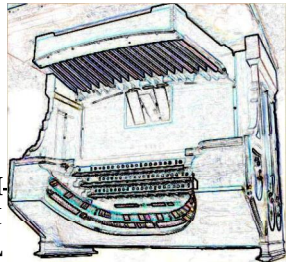
